Where are You?—Lost in Sin or Redeemed in God

Scripture Reading:

I. We are all sinners.

Romans 3:10-12 Even as it is written, "There is none righteous, not even one; ¹¹ There is none who understands, there is none who seeks out God. ¹² All have turned aside; together they have become useless; there is none who does good; there is not so much as one..."

Romans 3:23 For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.

Proverbs 20:9 Who can say, I have made my heart clean; / I am pure from my sin?

Proverbs 30:11-12 There is a generation that curses their father, / And do not bless their mother. ¹² There is a generation that are pure in their own eyes, / And yet are not washed from their filthiness.

1 John 5:17a All unrighteousness is sin.

John 8:44 You are of your father the devil, and you want to do the desires of your father. He was a murderer from the beginning and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks the lie, he speaks it out of his own possessions; for he is a liar and the father of it.

II. All sinners will be judged by God:

A. Those who have not believed will be judged and will suffer eternal punishment in the lake of fire which is prepared for the devil and his angels.

B. Those who have believed will not be judged by God but will enjoy eternal life.

Ezekiel 18:4b The soul who sins, he shall die.

Revelation 21:8b Their part will be in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death.

III. Jesus took all our sins on Himself to the cross:

- A. He is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world.
- B. He bore all our sins in His body on the cross when He suffered and died for us.
- C. He shed His precious blood to take away all our sins.
- D. Through Christ's redemption we are forgiven and cleansed by God.

WHERE ARE YOU?

John 1:29 The next day he saw Jesus coming to him and said, Behold, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

Isaiah 53:5-6 But He was wounded because of our transgressions; / He was crushed because of our iniquities; / The chastening for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we have been healed. ⁶ We all like sheep have gone astray; / Each of us has turned to his own way, and Jehovah has caused the iniquity of us all / To fall on Him.

- **1 Peter 2:24** Who Himself bore up our sins in His body on the tree... by whose bruise you were healed.
- **1 Peter 1:18-19** Knowing that *it was* not with corruptible things, with silver or gold, *that* you were redeemed from your vain manner of life handed down from your fathers, ¹⁹ But with precious blood, as of a Lamb without blemish and without spot, *the blood* of Christ.
- 1 John 1:7b And the blood of Jesus His Son cleanses us from every sin.

Ephesians 1:7 In whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of offenses, according to the riches of His grace.

IV. We must:

- A. *Admit* we are guilty and *repent*, turning away from our sins and turning to God.
- B. **Believe** Jesus is the Savior from sin.
- C. *Confess* our sins to the Lord.

Proverbs 28:13 He who covers his transgressions will not prosper, but whoever confesses and forsakes *them* will obtain mercy.

Acts 3:19 Repent therefore and turn, that your sins may be wiped away.

- **John 3:16, 18** For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that every one who believes into Him would not perish, but would have eternal life. ¹⁸ He who believes into Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe has been condemned already, because he has not believed into the name of the only begotten Son of God.
- **1 John 1:8-9** If we say that we do not have sin, we are deceiving ourselves, and the truth is not in us. ⁹ If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

V. God will forgive us; we will be justified, and our sins will be wiped away.

Isaiah 43:25 I, even I, am He who wipes away your transgressions for My own sake, / And I will not remember your sins.

Psalm 103:12 As far as the east is from the west, / So far has He removed our transgressions from us.

Micah 7:19b And You will cast into the depths of the sea / All their sins.
